Love One Another.38

John 13:34-35 - *A new command I give you: Love one another. Just as I have loved you, so you must love one another.
*By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.

Our Lord Jesus commands us to love one another as He has loved us because us accepting one another is the nature of His church and contempt and judgement are not. This is what we have in <u>Romans 14:1-4</u>.

'Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters.

'One person's faith allows them to eat anything, but another, whose faith is weak, eats only vegetables.

'The one who eats everything must not treat with contempt the one who does not.

and the one show does not eat everything must not judge the one who does, for God has accepted them.

'Who are you to judge some else's servant? To their own master, servants stand or fall.

And they will stand, for the Lord is able to make them stand.

These verses correct something that should never have needed correction for if we are all truly agape loving one another, then there will be no quarreling over disputable matters, no one treating one another with contempt and no one judging one another. There are many issues of a similar matter today in the church, but the Lord's command is still the same - Accept one another, don't treat one another with contempt and don't judge one another.

Therefore, as we seek the Lord, let's ask Him to help us truly agape love another, which means for us all to accept one another and to resist holding one another in contempt or judging one another. Let's fully agape love all who belong to Jesus and look forward to what the Lord can do among us now and also to the day when He shall make us all stand before Him in Heaven, where forever there is no contempt or judgment. Lord Jesus, help us truly love one another just as you have loved us! Amen!
