**John 13:34-35 - "A new command I give you: Love one another. Just as I have loved you, so you must love one another. "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.**

The Lord Jesus commanded us to love one another as He has loved us as this is a major part of His plan to make us all stand before Him and be with Him forever. This really is the main thrust of Romans 14:1-4.

**'Accept the one whose faith is weak, without quarreling over disputable matters.**

**and the one who does not eat everything must not judge the one who does, for God has accepted them.**  
**'Who are you to judge some else's servant? To their own master, servants stand or fall.**  
**And they will stand, for the Lord is able to make them stand.**

Our Lord Jesus is our Master. It's before Him that any of us either stand or fall and the main point here is the Lord is able to make us all stand before Him in Heaven even if we live before Him differently down here on Earth. Many times we are too quick to judge one another and treat one another's actions with a scowl or a frown. But, since we serve the same Master, the Lord Jesus, before Whom we all stand or fall, we should always be quick to love one another instead, for this helps all of us be prepared to hear from the Lord on the day we stand before Him, "Well done, good and faithful servant! Enter into the joy of my Heaven!"

Therefore, as we seek the Lord, let's ask Him to help us truly agape love another so that we can help each other stand before Him, looking forward to being with the Lord Jesus forever in Heaven. Let's give no place to rushing to judge each other or to treat each other with contempt. And, let's keep looking forward to loving each other, preparing each other for the day when we will each appear before the Lord for He most assuredly is able to make us all stand in His Presence and be with Him forever. Lord Jesus, help us truly love one another just as you have loved us! Amen!
