Therefore, as we seek the Lord today, let's ask Him to help us understand where the line is and when we cross it with regards to boasting about ourselves. Let's always resist going for our own glory, taking credit for what the Lord is doing in us and through us. And, let's live in the freedom the Lord gives us to not boast about ourselves and rejoice whenever we can and wherever we are in the great things the Lord is doing all around us as we agape love one another. Lord Jesus, help us truly love one another just as you have loved us and bring glory and honor to You! Amen!
