Vision 2018 — Church without Borders, without Walls!

Many things have happened since our last newsletter in December 2016. We were unable to purchase the church property highlighted in the December 2016 newsletter. We are still without a building for our meetings and services. Our numbers are still at 6 people (USA, Malaysia, S. Korea and Columbia) per week. We sought the LORD in prayer, asking if He is not pleased with us, if He still wants us to go on, or should we just fold FCF.

That very night of prayer, the LORD responded—

“The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on me, because the LORD has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the LORD’s favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion —, to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the LORD for the display of his splendor.”
