Let's resist any desire to mock those who have hurt us when bad things happen to them. And, let's be glad that we don't have to be like that anymore because of the power of His great love and that we can instead help fill the earth with the knowledge of His glory as the waters cover the sea by loving <u>ALL</u> who have wronged us. <u>Lord Jesus, help us truly love one another just as you have loved us and bring glory and honor to You! Amen!</u>
