Thus, each taste of Him fills this earth with more knowledge of His glory, more knowledge of Him and of how good and great He truly is.

Therefore, as we seek the Lord today, let's ask Him to show us how to taste and see that He is good more often than we do now. Let's resist depending on others to see that He is good when we can taste Him for ourselves. And, let's rejoice and be glad that each day we can taste and see that He is good by excelling in love and prayer and can help fill this earth with the knowledge of His glory as the waters cover the sea. Lord Jesus, help us truly love one another just as you have loved us and bring glory and honor to You! Amen!
