Therefore, as we seek the Lord today, let's ask Him to help us remember the miracles He's already done for each of us and get ready to rejoice at the many miracles He's going to yet do. Let's resist grumbling at His miracles as the crowd did here, resenting the messenger so they rejected His message that His miracles were confirming. And, let's be thankful that each time the Lord does a miracle it shows that eternal life is available for all to believe and receive it and also be thankful that by His mighty power He has changed us, making it so that we can excel in love and prayer and can help fill this earth with the knowledge of His glory as the waters cover the sea. **Lord Jesus, help us truly love one another just as you have loved us and bring glory and honor to You! Amen!**
